Strawberry, Apple Festivals – Craft Exhibitors

Date and Hours	Usually the 3 rd Saturday of June and the 3 rd Saturday of October from 10am-4pm. Exact dates will be posted at the beginning of the calendar year. You will be advised of your arrival and setup time prior to the festival date.
Place	Old Grace Church Grounds – Merrick Road & Cedar Shore Drive, Massapequa. Massapequa's Historic Complex – Home of the Historical Society of the Massapequas.
Fee and Space	A 10 X 10 space is \$50.00 per festival. You must bring your own setup, including tables. There is no electricity. There is no commission on your sales.
Eligible Exhibits	Artists and Craftspeople are invited to display and sell their original work. Items must be artistic and of high quality. All items displayed must be the work of the registered craftsperson. We reserve the right to limit the number of persons per category. A photo of your work is necessary for us to process your application. If you have already applied to our festivals and submitted a photo and your craft line has not changed, an additional photo is not necessary. No raffles, markdowns or discount signs are allowed.
Applications	Send \$50.00 per festival along with completed application to: Historical Society of the Massapequas, c/o Name of Festival, 4755 Merrick Rd. P.O. Box 211, Massapequa Place, NY 11758. Registration must be received by no later than a month prior to the festival date. If you are not accepted, your check will be returned. Make checks payable to: Historical Society of the Massapequas.
